

Macaulay Honors College graduates have a history of successful transition to graduate schools nationwide for advanced study in a diverse range of fields. Nearly one-third (**32%**) of students in the class of 2016 enrolled in a graduate program within one year of graduation.

### Graduate Degree Fields and Types

Class of 2016 graduates pursued advanced degrees in fields such as law, medicine, engineering, education, art history and psychology. Of those who pursued advanced degrees, nearly half enrolled in medical degree programs. Master's degree programs were another popular option, followed by law schools and doctoral programs.
