Class of 2018

Macaulay Honors College graduates have a history of successful transition to graduate schools and employment in a diverse range of industries. Nearly one-fifth (18%) of students in the Class of 2018 enrolled in a graduate program and more than half (52%) were employed within one year of graduation.¹

Graduate Degree Fields and Types

Class of 2018 graduates pursued advanced degrees in fields such as law, medicine, English, social work, and biochemistry. Of those who pursued advanced degrees, nearly half (45%) pursued master's degrees.

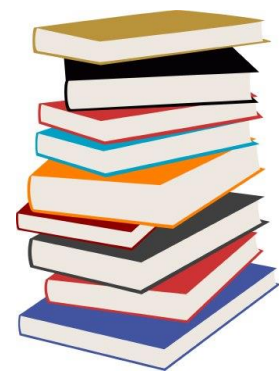
